



Northwest Regional Airport Terrace-Kitimat

Access to the Northwest Regional Airport Terrace-Kitimat (YXT) apron and taxiways:

RESTRICTED AREA

As regulated by Transport Canada the Apron at YXT has a restricted area, this covers aircraft stands #1 and #2.

Regulations state that only scheduled aircraft carrying screened passengers requiring enplaning or deplaning are permitted to park on these stands during this period

The entrance to the Air Terminal located within the restricted area is by regulation of Transport Canada is for the use of screened passengers.

Non-RESTRICTED Apron areas

YXT has two (2) non restricted aircraft parking areas these are aircraft stand #3 and the itinerant aircraft parking area located in the south east corner of the apron.

All aircraft carrying non screened passengers are required to park either on stand #3 or in the itinerant aircraft parking area which is located in the south east corner of the apron.

Passengers from non screened flights requiring access to and from the terminal building or to the aircraft must use the Pilot's Access Gate which is located on the south east corner of the terminal building or make other arrangements with the Airport Manager.

As REGULATED BY TRANSPORT CANADA PILOTS MUST BE IN COMPLETE CARE AND CONTROL OF THEIR PASSENGERS WHILE ON THE APRON.

Aircraft parking for extended periods of time (longer than deplaning and enplaning your passengers) must park in the itinerant aircraft parking area located in the south east corner of the apron and not on Stand #3.

Taxi A and B

YXT has two taxiways, all of Taxi "A" and a portion of Taxi "B" is vehicle controlled. The first 1,300 feet of Taxi "B" from the Apron to west of the compass rose is not vehicle controlled. Pedestrian access to the first 1,300 feet of Taxi "B" from the apron is permitted with an escort from a person holding a valid pilots license. The remainder of Taxi "B" to the threshold of Runway 03/21 is vehicle controlled. Access to this area is through radio communication only.

YXT Apron Services
