The **Summer Student – Grounds & Facilities Support** will assist the airport maintenance team with general groundside upkeep and operational support duties during the summer season. This entry-level position provides a hands-on opportunity to work in a dynamic airport environment, supporting both daily operations and special projects.

## **Job Duties:**

Below is an outline of the job's primary duties and requirements, which is not all-inclusive. Incumbent(s) may be expected to perform job-related duties other than those contained in this document and may be required to have specific job-related knowledge and skills.

- Performing groundskeeping duties such as mowing grass, trimming, weeding, and watering plants
- Painting fences, curbs, and other designated surface areas
- Ensuring outdoor areas, including walkways, parking lots, and terminal surroundings, are clean and free of debris (e.g., sweeping, raking, and garbage removal)
- Cleaning airport vehicles and light equipment
- Assisting with general facility tidiness, including garbage removal and basic cleaning tasks
- Supporting basic facility inspections and participating in minor airport safety checks
- Operating light tools and landscaping equipment such as lawnmowers, leaf blowers, and tool cats, including routine maintenance, lubrication, and fueling
- Observing all airport safety and security regulations
- Following safe work methods and using safety equipment; securing worksites from potential hazards as required
- Maintaining essential records of work performed
- Performing other general labour duties as assigned by the Supervisor of Operations

## **Qualifications:**

- A minimum of Grade 12 education
- Be enrolled in or returning to a post-secondary institution
- A valid Class 5 or 7 Driver's License
- A self-motivated and reliable work ethic, with the ability to work independently
- Willingness to work outdoors in a variety of weather conditions



# **Physical Requirements:**

- This role requires the ability to perform light to moderate physical tasks such as lifting, bending, walking, and standing for extended periods
- This role requires comfort working outdoors in various weather conditions
- This role requires the ability to safely operate and handle small tools and maintenance equipment
